Honors Program Informational Agreement

The purpose of this agreement is to provide the Honors student with all the requirements to be eligible to enter the Honors Program, or remain in the Honors Program.

Criteria

- High School graduate, G.E.D. or equivalent.
- Complete and turn in this Honors Program application.
- Hold a minimum G.P.A of 3.25 or higher with a minimum of twelve **completed** credit hours (must be 100 level or above) at one or any combination of MCCCDC college(s).
- Enroll in a minimum of one (1) – three (3) credit Honors class – preferably an Honors Only class.
- Award amount is based on the number of credit hours for which the student is enrolled. Awards are for Fall and Spring semesters only (does not apply to the Summer semesters).
- To be eligible for the monies twelve credit hours must **already be completed** within the Maricopa Community College District.

Prop 300: State law now requires that a person who is not a citizen or legal resident of the United States or who is without lawful immigration status is not entitled to classification as an in-state student pursuant to A.R.S. Section 15-1802 or entitled to classification as a county resident pursuant to A.R.S. Section 15-1902.01.

According to state law, a person who is not a citizen of the United States, who is without lawful immigration status, and who is enrolled at any community college under the jurisdiction of an Arizona community college district is not entitled to tuition waivers, fee waivers, grants, scholarship assistance, financial aid, tuition assistance or any other type of financial assistance that is subsidized or paid in whole or in part with state monies.

Retention

In order to continue to receive an Honors Fee Award, eligible students must maintain a 3.25 GPA and successfully complete (earn at least a grade of C or higher) an Honors class each semester. Students who do not successfully meet all the criteria will not be eligible to receive a Fee Award the following semester. Students who have not met all the criteria must reapply to the Honors Program if they have not been participating in the program for more than two semesters.

Graduating from the Honors Program

- Complete a minimum of 15 Honors credits (pass/fail credits excluded) and 1 credit of Service Learning.
- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- Petition for Graduation at the Records Office (see appropriate class schedule for deadlines).
