- Must be a High School graduate or have been certified as having passed the GED
- Must be working toward a degree, certification program, and/or transfer program
- Must have a cumulative 3.75 GPA or better (out of a possible 4.0) in all college credit coursework completed within the last five years
- Must have completed at least 12 credit hours at MCC in 100 level courses or above
- Must have participated in a MCC campus organization/program/sport/ special event
- Must have completed at least one community service/service-learning activity while you have been at MCC
- Students must be on track to earn an Associate or a Bachelor degree
- Must have a community college record free of suspension, probation, and serious disciplinary action, and must enjoy full rights of citizenship in his/her country (none have been or remain abridged due to criminal conduct)
- Please note that any information from this application may become public through local and national media
